



Alcohol Hand Gel

ALCOHOL-BASED HAND GELS FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING HANDS IMMEDIATELY ANYWHERE, WITHOUT NEED OF WATER

Using an alcohol-based hand sanitiser can help decrease the transmission of flu and virus. This makes it ideal for use around critical infection control zones.

This alcohol hand gel is a personal care product, which is not classed as dangerous if used according to the label and directions.

MAIN USAGE INCLUDES

- Protecting from flu
- Protecting from virus

DIRECTIONS

Put two shots from the bottle (approx. 3ml) into physically clean hands. Rub into the hands for a full 30 seconds, ensuring that all areas are covered until dry.

INGREDIENTS

Alcohol Denat, Aqua, Acrylates/C10-30, Alkyl Acrylate, Crosspolymer, Triethanolamine, Propylene Glycol, Perfume, Butylphenyl, Methylpropional, Citronellol, Linalool, CI42090

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place below 25 degrees

CAUTION

Flammable liquid and vapour. Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames, hot surfaces. No smoking. Keep container tightly closed.

If swallowed: Call a Poison Centre or Doctor if you feel unwell.

If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing.
